INSTRUCTIONS FOR RENEWAL (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

VALID LICENSE REQUIRED

Pursuant to Section 7317 of the Business and Professions Code, it is illegal for you to work without a valid, unexpired license issued by the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology. The renewal fee shown below must be paid by the date your license expires. If you are working with an expired license you will be cited. The current fine amount is \$1,000.

NAME CHANGE

Name changes cannot be made at the time of renewal. Please access the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology's website and print, complete and submit the form "Request for Name Change" to the Board. You must include a photocopy of a current U.S. Government issued photographic identification, along with ONE of the following U.S. documents: Certified Court Order, Marriage Certificate, Court Order of Dissolution of Marriage, Declaration/Registration of Domestic Partnership, or a Notarized Document of Name Change.

ADDRESS CHANGE

Pursuant to Section 7400 of the Business and Profession Code you must submit an address change to this Board within 30 days of your move. Failure to do so may result in your renewal notice not arriving at your current address.

Note: Address changes submitted at the time of renewal will add 6 weeks to the processing time for your license. Allow sufficient processing time so you are not working with an expired license.

CANCELLED LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 7418 of the Business and Profession Code, a license that is not renewed within five years following its expiration date shall be deemed cancelled and cannot be renewed, restored, reinstated, or reissued. A new license may be obtained only by submitting an application, paying all required fees, and qualifying for and passing the examination.

PAYMENT OF FINES OWED

Pursuant to Section 7414 of the Business and Professions Code, you will not be allowed to renew any license issued to you until all outstanding fines are paid in addition to any renewal or delinquency fees.
