



ACCELAWRAP INSTRUCTIONS

Since 1983, Backscratchers® has offered professional, innovative, easy-to-use products. We've done it again with the Accelawrap® Fast Brush-On System. This System makes it possible to do a set of nails in 30 minutes or less that are easy-to-apply and cost-effective. Please read and follow the instructions, and we will take you through step by step to a perfect set of nails.

PROFESSIONAL SALON SANITATION

Practicing proper sanitation is one of the most important steps in professional applications of nail systems. Prior to beginning the service, dispense marble size amounts of Foamaseptic™ into your client's hands, then into yours. Completely massage in, then wipe with a clean towel. Another practice of salon sanitation is the use of the SeptiFile® Sanitizable File System, featuring replaceable abrasives and handles that can be disinfected. Use new abrasives and clean handle for each client.

SPEED TECHNIQUE: When working with the Accelawrap Fast Brush-On System, apply Accelabond to 4 nails and activate all 4 with Accelerator. Do the next 4 nails and activate, then do the 2 thumbs and activate. **When applying product, do not touch product to client's cuticle; this causes lifting.**

PREPARATION

1. **Remove polish** with Stripr®, a mild non-acetone nail polish remover, using a Nail Neat or Neat & Tidy.
2. **Cleanse** hands and nails with Hygienic Elegance® Cleansing Wash.
3. **Rinse** hands and nails with warm water and dry thoroughly. **NOTE: DO NOT use primers or dehydrators.**
4. **Push back cuticles** gently with rubber-tipped cuticle pusher.
5. **Trim** natural nails, leaving approximately 1/16" (1.5 mm) of free edge.
6. **Shape** free edge of natural nails using 240 grit file (recommend the use of SepiFile® Sanitizable File System).



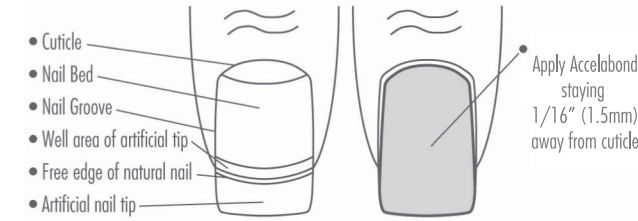
7. **Remove shine** from natural nails with 600 grit file and wipe the dust from the nail using a Nail Neat or Neat & Tidy.



APPLICATION

Application will always follow the **SPEED TECHNIQUE** (defined below steps #1-5) except when instructed to apply to all 10 nails. **NOTE: DO NOT allow resin to touch cuticle; this causes lifting.**

1. **Apply Accelabond** to 4 nails staying 1/16" (1.5 mm) away from the cuticles. **NOTE: Always use a thin coat of resin.**



2. **Activate** by holding Accelerator 4-5" (11-12 cm) from nail.
3. **Repeat** steps #1-2 for other 4 nails.
4. **Apply Accelabond** to the 2 thumbs.
5. **Activate** with Accelerator.
6. **Remove shine** from where the artificial tip will be applied using a 240 grit file or White Block Buffer. **NOTE: Be sure to remove shine only on the free edge and remove dust using a Nail Neat or Neat & Tidy.**
7. **Apply Accelabond** to the free edge where the artificial tip is going to be applied.
8. **Apply tip** holding the tip at a 45-degree angle, slide the tip until the ledge meets natural nail, then rock tip forward. Hold with firm pressure for 5-10 seconds.
9. **Apply Accelabond** to seam line of all 10 nails. **NOTE: The seam line is where the artificial tip meets the natural nail.**
10. **Activate** with Accelerator.
11. **Cut tip** to desired length and shape tip using a 240 grit file. **NOTE: If applying Natural tips you will need to blend well area with a 100 then 240 grit file. If applying French Pearl or French White tips no blending is necessary.**
12. **Apply Silk or Fiberglass** Stress Strip to all 10 nails (half on the tip and half on the natural nail), trim excess using Stork Shears. **NOTE: Be sure to stay 1/16" (1.5 mm) from edges.**
13. **Apply Accelabond** to saturate the Stress Strips on all 10 nails.
14. **Reapply Accelabond and activate** with Accelerator using the **SPEED TECHNIQUE**.
15. **Apply Silk or Fiberglass** Pre-Cut Cuticle Fit to all 10 nails staying 1/16" (1.5 mm) from all edges, including free edge.



16. **Apply Accelabond** to saturate the fiberglass or silk on all 10 nails (first coat). **NOTE: Make sure to seal all edges of the fiberglass or silk.**



17. **Reapply Accelabond** to saturate the fiberglass or silk until transparent and activate with Accelerator using the **SPEED TECHNIQUE** (second coat).

18. **Reapply Accelabond and Accelerator** two more times using the **SPEED TECHNIQUE** (total of 4 coats).

THE FINISH

1. **Smooth** entire nail surface and blend product around the cuticle using a 240 grit file and then a 600 grit file. For a glossy shine use White and Gray buffers over entire nail surface. **NOTE: Do not over file.**

2. **Cleanse** hands with Hygienic Elegance.

Optional: In place of using the White and Gray Buffers and to **save time** you can add a **permanent high-gloss shine** using Extreme Glaze Sealer. You will want to apply 3 coats of Glaze Sealer waiting 60 seconds between each coat. **NOTE: If applying polish, use only one coat of Extreme Glaze Sealer. NOTE: Glaze Sealer will not adhere to natural nails, or to other base or topcoats.**

3. **Apply Nail Radiance®** Cuticle Treatment to cuticles and underneath the nail tips, then massage into the cuticles. **NOTE: If using Glaze Sealer, wait until it is dry (about 60 seconds) before applying Nail Radiance.**

MAINTENANCE

After approximately 2 weeks it will be time for re-glazing. Reminder – Do not coat entire nail surface with Accelabond for each maintenance service. Too much Accelabond will cause the nail to become thick and improperly balanced.

1. **Sanitize** your hands and your client's hands using Foamaseptic.
2. **Remove polish** using Stripr. If you have used Glaze Sealer remove using 240 grit file or White Block Buffer.
3. **Cleanse** hands and nails with Hygienic Elegance. **DO NOT USE PRIMERS.**
4. **Push back cuticles.**
5. **Remove shine** from the entire nail including the new growth area using a 240 grit file and wipe dust from the nail using a Nail Neat or Neat & Tidy.
6. **Apply Accelabond** to new growth area, slightly overlapping old product. **NOTE: It is critical to keep coats of Accelabond thin.**
7. **Activate** with Accelerator.

8. **Repeat** steps #6-7.

9. Follow FINISH steps #1-3. **NOTE: When reducing the length or reshaping the nail, file to desired length. Be sure to reseal the free edge with Accelabond and activate with Accelerator.**

After approximately 4 weeks it will be time for reglazing with fiberglass or silk.

1. **Sanitize** your hands and your client's hands using Foamaseptic.

2. **Remove polish** using Stripr. If you have used Glaze Sealer remove using 240 grit file or White Block Buffer.

3. **Cleanse** hands and nails with Hygienic Elegance. **DO NOT USE PRIMERS.**

4. **Push back cuticles.**

5. **Remove shine** from the entire nail including the new growth area using a 240 grit file and wipe dust from the nail using a Nail Neat or Neat & Tidy.

6. **Apply Accelabond** to new growth area, slightly overlapping old product. **NOTE: It is critical to keep coats of Accelabond thin.**

7. **Activate** with Accelerator.

8. **Repeat** steps #6-7.

9. **Place Pre-Cut Stress Strip** (fiberglass or silk) in the new growth area, slightly overlapping old product.

10. **Apply Accelabond and Accelerator** to fiberglass or silk on all 10 nails, making sure to seal all of the edges (first coat).

11. **Apply Accelabond and Accelerator** to new growth area using the **SPEED TECHNIQUE** (second coat).

12. Repeat step #11 (third coat).

13. **Apply Accelabond and Accelerator** to entire nail using the **SPEED TECHNIQUE** (final coat). **NOTE: Keep this coat thin.**

14. Follow FINISH steps #1-3. **NOTE: When reducing length or reshaping the nail, it is important to reseal the free edge with Accelabond and activate with Accelerator.**

NATURAL NAIL WRAPS

1. Follow PREPARATION steps #1-4 and #7.

2. Follow APPLICATION steps #1-5.

3. Follow APPLICATION steps #12-15 for a nail that is longer than an active length or if your client has a lot of problems in stress area of nail. **NOTE: If your client's nails are an active length you may skip this step and go to step #4.**

4. Follow APPLICATION steps #15-18 for all nail lengths.

5. Follow FINISH steps #1-3.

REMOVAL

1. **Apply Moisture Jubileeee**® Dry Skin Cream to the skin surrounding the nail plate area. This will reduce the drying effect of acetone on the skin.

2. **Soak** nails in acetone. **NOTE: Removal should take approximately 20 minutes.**

3. **Cleanse** hands thoroughly with Hygienic Elegance after the product is removed.

4. **Condition** natural nail with Nail Radiance. Use 3-stage buffing method on natural nails: 600 grit, White and Gray buffers.
